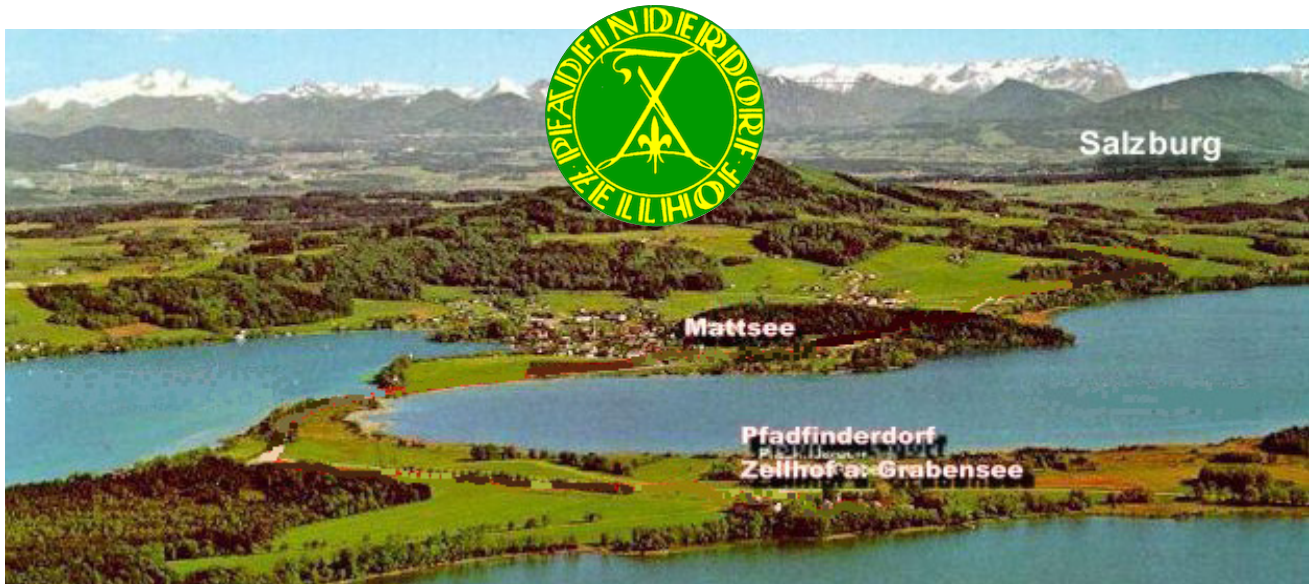


ZELLHOF AUSTRIA 2020



Scouts Northamptonshire

A trip to Zellhof International Scout Camp Austria is to take place in 2020 and open to all Scouters and young people born before 01/02/2009. The camp is being organised by an experienced team of County Scout leaders with broad International Scouting experience and a few of them have visited and camped at Zellhof a number of times before.

Zellhof was an old estate owned previously by the church now restored by Salzburg Scouts, today a large International campsite with camp areas and inside accommodation with toilets and showers to cater for the needs of everyone, run today by a voluntary group of multilingual and multinational Scouters.

Zellhof is located on the edge of lake Grabensee one of the warmest lakes for bathing in the region of Salzburg and in the middle of a nature conservation area, an ideal location 12 miles from Salzburg with the local village of Mattsee a mile away within easy walking distance of Zellhof.

The trip will cover twelve days leaving Northamptonshire on the 24th July returning on 3rd August, the outward journey to Austria will have an overnight stop in France in the town of Metz, this will be repeated on the return journey. The days in between will be at Zellhof with an exciting range of activities and trips planned to make it a scout camp to remember.
